Issue of land change for Industrial Estate at Dhanubhanga, Rongjuli, Goalpara, Assam

The Assam Industrial Development Corporation (AIDC), Govt. of Assam requested for change of the location for the project "Industrial estate at Dhanubhanga, Rongjuli, Goalpara, Assam approved in FY 2019-20 due to dispute between the Forest Department and Revenue Department of Govt. of Assam on land allotted for the project and allocation of new land by the Revenue & Disaster Management Department, Govt. of Assam in the same Revenue Circle.

The project was approved by the PAMC in 8th meeting held on 12.03.2020 with total project cost of Rs. 14.30 Cr., Gol grant Rs.

8.00 Cr. & State share of Rs. 6.30 Cr. The 1st installment of Rs. 3.20 Cr. was released for the project in March 2021 to initiate the project.

The representative of the Govt. of Assam informed that no Gol grant of Rs. 3.20 Cr. has been utilized by the Implementing Agency, released for the project.

The committee acceded to the request of Govt. of Assam for change of Location of the project "Industrial estate at vill-Dhanubhanga, Rongjuli, Goalpara, Assam to new location at vill-Gerua, Rongjuli, Goalpara, Assam with a permission to utilize Rs. 3.20 Cr. already released as Government of India Grant for the project without changing the basic profile of the approved project.

The committee also asked to Govt. of Assam to re-submit a fresh DPR for the project with new location details, land documents, geo tagging details along with the previously approved activities under the project. The Govt. of Assam shall ensure the timely completion of the project without delay.

Concluding remarks:

AS&DC (MSME) requested the representatives of the State Governments to give impetus to the scheme in their States and also to other schemes of the Ministry including "PM Vishwakarma" Scheme.

Secretary (MSME) highlighted the importance of ensuring full accomplishment of deliverables envisaged with projects and smoothly passing the benefits to Micro and Small Enterprises. He also asked to forward more proposals under the scheme and ensure time bound completion of the on-going projects.
